MEMO TO: All Buffalo Teachers

RE: Snow Days

We have spoken with NYSUT and the District. As of today, it appears that we have used five (5) snow/cold days; January 3rd, 7th and 8th, January 28th and 29th.

Therefore the school calendar should reflect that:

- for PreK-8 and 9-12, there are four (4) not two (2) days of student attendance for week #1, (September 2-6). Superintendent's Days count as days of student attendance.
- for 9-12, there are five (5) not one (1) day of student attendance for week 22 (January 27-31). Regents days count as days of student attendance
- for 9-12, there are five (5) not one (1) day of student attendance for week 42 (June 16-20)

and

four (4) not one (1) day of student attendance for week 43 (June 23-26).
Regents days count as days of student attendance.

Bottom Line:

- There are 180 days of required student attendance.
- Both PreK-8 and 9-12 have 186 days scheduled (95+91=186).
- We have used five (5) snow/cold days.
- $186-5=181$.

Therefore, we have one (1) snow/cold day left, plus should we agree, May 23rd, the Friday before Memorial Day.

- If we can use the remaining two (2) Superintendent's Days, we have three (3) snow/cold days available. Apparently, the District has planned to use the April 9th and May 7th Superintendent's Conference Days for correcting State Exams. They are checking on this.

Worst case scenario, one (1) day left plus May 23rd.

Best case scenario, three (3) days left plus May 23rd.
